What are cookies?

Cookies are small pieces of data that websites store on a device. We use Cookies to improve our users' browsing experience because they help the website remember preferences and understand how people use different features.

Most of the cookies on ZIBRIO Website is used by Squarespace, the platform on which our website sits and operates. For your convenience, we incorporated Squarespace's cookies policy herein. Please note that some of the cookies on Squarespace's policy may not be used on ZOBRIO website.

Functional and required cookies

Squarespace uses some necessary cookies so visitors can navigate and use key features on websites. These cookies vary from site to site depending on the features it uses. For example, functional and required cookies help these features work:

- Customer accounts
- Shopping cart and checkout
- URL redirects

| hasCart | Tells Squarespace that the visitor has a cartCookieTwo weeks |
| Locked | Prevents the password-protected screen from displaying if a visitor enters the correct site-wide password. Cookie Session |
| PHPSESSID | Securely authenticates a visitor during their checkout in Scheduling Cookie One month |
| RecentRedirect | Prevents redirect loops if a site has <u>custom URL</u> <u>redirects</u>. Redirect loops are bad for SEO. Cookie 30 minutes |

| remember_client | Remembers Scheduling client's login details if they have an account Cookie 365 days |

| siteUserCrumb | Prevents <u>cross-site request forgery (CSRF)</u> for logged in site users Cookie Three years |
| SiteUserInfo | Identifies a visitor who logs into a <u>customer</u> account Cookie Three years |
| SiteUserSecureAuthToken | Authenticates a visitor who logs into a customer account Cookie Three years |
| squarespace-announcement-bar | Prevents the <u>announcement bar</u> from displaying if a visitor dismisses it localstorage Persistent |
| squarespace-likes | Shows when you've already "liked" a blog postlocalstoragePersistent |

| squarespace-popup-overlay | Prevents the <u>promotional pop-up</u> from displaying if a visitor dismisses it localstorage Persistent |

| squarespace-video-player-options | Remembers video player selected preferences (volume, playback speed, and quality) for videos <u>uploaded directly to Squarespace</u> localstorage Persistent |
| ss_cookieAllowed | Remembers if a visitor agreed to placing analytics cookies on their browser if a site is restricting the placement of cookies Cookie 30 days |
| ss_sd | Ensures that visitors on the <u>Squarespace 5</u> <u>platform</u> remain authenticated during their sessions Cookie Session |
| Test | Investigates if the browser supports cookies and prevents errors Cookie Session |
| TZ | Enables a Scheduling client's appointments to display correctly based on their time zone preferences. localstorage |

Cross-site request forgery (CSRF)

CSRF is an attack vector that tricks a browser into taking unwanted action in an application when someone's logged in. See https://support.squarespace.com/hc/en-us/articles/360000851908

Analytics and performance cookies

Squarespace use analytics and performance cookies to collect information on our behalf about how visitors interact with our site. Storing these cookies is how Squarespace populate the data you find in <u>Squarespace analytics</u>, such as <u>traffic sources</u>, <u>unique</u> <u>visitors</u>, and <u>cart abandonment</u>.

| ss_cvr | Two years | Identifies unique visitors and tracks a visitor's sessions on a site |
| ss_cvt | 30 minutes | Identifies unique visitors and tracks a visitor's sessions on a site |

Other Cookies ZIBRIO Utilizes

We use *Affiliatly* app for referral services. When the referral link is clicked, a cookie is stored on the visitor's device so *Affiliatly* knows that this is a referred visitor even though no order is made right away. *cookies are active for 14 days.*

When the visitor places an order, *Affiliatly* checks if they have an active cookie. If the visitor was referred by one of our affiliates, the order will be tracked and connected with the referred affiliate.

Instead of getting the IP address of the visitor, the app generates random and anonymous tokens when the referral link is clicked.
